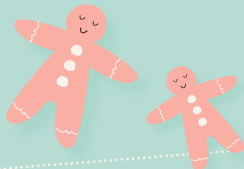

These will then be used in a ceiling-suspended installation. The project runs over 4 weeks. Please only book into one session.

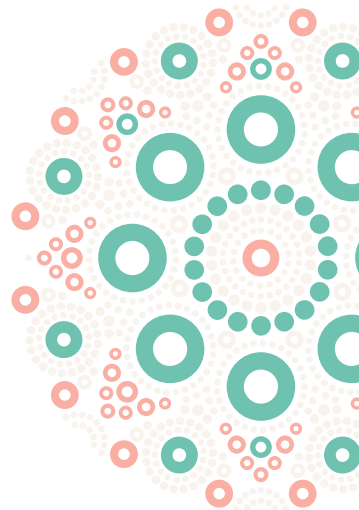
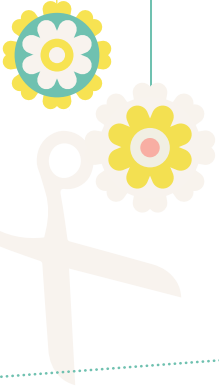
