Jualbup is an Aboriginal term meaning 'a place where water rises in the season of spring'. In the early days of European settlement, a timber miller named James Dyson worked in the area, and thus it became known as Dyson's Swamp. Later it was renamed Shenton Park Lake, after the land developer George Shenton. The Aboriginal name 'Jualbup' was restored to the lake in 1996.

## Mudurup **Coastal Trail**

Mudurup is one of many points along the Perth Coastline where Noongar ceremonies relating to the Kuranup (Noongar Heaven) would take place. In the spirit world the Wardang (Crow) would come and take the spirit of Noongar to its final resting place over the Wardan (Indian Ocean). The Kuranup is the resting place of the Noongar Wirin (spirit).
