## Perth Caravan & Camping Show – 22 March - 26 March 2023

The Perth Caravan & Camping Show will be running from 22 - 26 March 2023 inclusive at the Claremont Showgrounds. The Town will be implementing parking controls measures as set out in this letter to minimise disruption to residents and ensure public safety.

# **Temporary Parking Restrictions**

The Town will be implementing temporary parking restrictions to several streets around the Claremont Showground's precinct. The restrictions will apply for the duration of the event <u>only</u> and Rangers will be patrolling the areas. Please refer to the attached map for specification of temporary parking restrictions. Any vehicles parked contrary to signage will be infringed.

# **Precinct Parking**

Existing restrictions in place on Davies Road, Kyle Way, Lapsley Road, Second Avenue, Langsford Street, Mary Street, Shenton Place, Shenton Road, Smith Street, Reserve Street, The Cedus and Vaucluse Avenue will be temporarily changed to 8am - 6pm Wednesday to Sunday during the Camping and Caravan Show event only. Parking Permits will still apply to the increased parking restrictions. Please ensure parking permits are clearly displayed to avoid infringements.

### **Temporary Acrod Parking**

Current timed parking restrictions on **Graylands Road** between **Shenton Road** and **Kyle Way** and **Tiger Way**, between **Graylands Road** and **Shenton Road** will be replaced with temporary Acrod Parking bays.

### **Resident parking**

The Town will not issue temporary parking permits to residents. If temporary restrictions apply to your area for parking on the verge, then the resident will need to seek alternative parking arrangements during this time, or risk infringements.

### Management of street verges

Management of the verge is the responsibility of the resident of the property. Residents may allow people to park on their verge. No vehicles are permitted to be parked in an unsafe manner including across footpaths, blocking access to another property. Any vehicle found to be parked in this manner will be infringed.
